Silk Road - Navy

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## Throw Quilt Instructions approximate size: 50" x 59"

#### 1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut 3 - 7 1/2" strips

Fabric B - Cut 3 - 5" strips, subcut 9 - 5" x 9 1/2"

Fabric C - Cut 2 - 7 1/2" strips

**Fabric D** - Cut 2 - 5" strips, subcut 6 - 5" x 9 1/2"

Fabric E - Cut 2 - 5" strips

Fabric F - Cut 2 - 5" strips

Fabric G - Borders: Cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to

end, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" and

2 - 1 1/2" x 47 1/2"

Fabric H - Cut 2 - 5" strips

Fabric J - Cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips

Fabric K - Cut 2 - 5" strips


Fabric L - Cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips

**Fabric M** - Borders: Cut 6 - 2" strips, sew end to end, then subcut 2 - 2" x 56 1/2" and 2 - 2" x 50 1/2"


BINDING - Cut 7 - 2 1/4" strips sew end to end and press in half

## 2. Piecing Order:


1. Make 9 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) **Block #1**. Make 2 strip sets by sewing **J** 1 1/2" strips on both sides of 2 **A** 7 1/2" strips. Press toward **A**. Subcut 9 - 9 1/2" blocks.




Make 6 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) Block #2. Make
 strip sets by sewing L 1 1/2" strips on both sides of
 C 7 1/2" strips. Press toward C. Subcut 6 - 9 1/2" blocks.




3. Make 9 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) **Block #3**. First, make 1 strip set by sewing **E** and **F** 5" strips side by side, and make 1 strip set by sewing **E** and **H** 5" strips side by side. Press both strip sets toward the darker fabric. Subcut 9 - 2 3/4" segments from each strip set. Then sew **E**/**F** segments to the top and sew **E**/**H** segments to the bottom of 9 **B** 5" x 9 1/2" according to the diagram.



4. Make 6 - 9" finished (9 1/2" unf.) **Block #4.** First, make 1 strip set by sewing **F** and **K** 5" strips side by side, and make 1 strip set by sewing **K** and **H** 5" strips side by side. Press toward the darker fabrics. Then subcut 6 - 2 3/4" segments from each strip set. Sew **F**/**K** segments to the top and sew **K**/**H** segments to the bottom of 6 **D** 5" x 9 1/2" according to the diagram.



- 5. Arrange blocks in order according to the diagram. Sew blocks into rows then sew rows together.
- 6. Sew **G** 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" to SIDES of the quilt, then sew **G** 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM.
- 7. Sew **M** 2" x 56 1/2" to the SIDES, then sew **M** 2" x 50 1/2" to the TOP and BOTTOM.
- 8. The Throw Quilt measures approximately 50 1/2" x 59 1/2". Make backing (Fabric I) at least 8" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric M) and enjoy!!



## Pillow #1 and #2 Instructions approximate size: 18" x 18" each

#### 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - Cut 1 - 14 1/2" x 14 1/2" square (#1) **Fabric C** - Cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 16 1/2"

Cut 1 - 5" strip, subcut 4 - 5" x 9 1/2" (#2) BACKINGS - Cut 1 - 18 1/2" strip, subcut

2 - 18 1/2" squares (#1, 2) **Fabric D** - Cut 1 - 5" strip (#2)


Fabric E - Cut 1 - 2 1/2" strip, subcut

2 - 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" (#1)


Fabric G - Cut 1 - 5" strip (#2)

## 2. Piecing Order:


1. **Pillow #1**: make 1 - 18" finished block (18 1/2" unf.). Sew **E** and **C** 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips around **A** 14 1/2" square according to the numerical order of the diagram. The first seam is a partial seam (sew approximately 10") with the remainder of the seam sewn last. Press each seam toward the strip before adding the next strip.




Pillow #2: make 1 - 18" finished block (18 1/2" unf.). First make 1 strip set by sewing D and G 5" strips side by side. Press toward the darker fabric. Subcut 8 - 2 3/4" segments. Next sew D/G segments to the top and bottom of 4 C 5" 9 1/2" according to the diagram.



Then sew pieced units together by rows according to the diagram for 1 large block.



3. Finishing the pillows: Place pillow top and backing (**Fabric C**) right sides together. Stitch 1/4" around the outer edge, leaving approximately 8" open in the middle of 1 side for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Press. Stuff with fiberfill or pillow form. Stitch opening closed. Enjoy!!
